Thanks so much for taking time to communicate with me again. I feel almost ashamed that I have not even said 'thank you' for sending the books for my daughter-in-law. I am sure you will not remember, but I had told you about my precious daughter-in-law and her interest in the teachings of Brother Branham. You were so very kind to send to me books regarding the serpent's seed, and the other books about Brother Branham's life.

I wanted to let you know that not only has my precious daughter-in-law enjoyed the books so much, but, just last Sunday, I gave them to the assistant pastor at one of the local churches here near us, and he has been reading with great interest. He has been aware of Brother Branham, but had never read at length any messages, etc. So.....needless to say, the books are having a 'teaching journey.' "Libbe"

But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God. [Acts 5:39]

Lately, many of you have had trouble accessing our site. This is due to the limited bandwidth (300K up/down) we currently can afford. This allows us only to support a peak of 12 listeners, 90,000 Webhits/month and 40,000 downloaded Files/ Messages/month.

As you can see from the statistics on page 3, since Oct. 2002, our humble setup is being choked with the astronomical growth in visitors (about 90% are nonbelievers of this end time message) to our site. For this month, we had 435,611 Webhits, listener peak of 27, and 128,887 files/Messages downloaded.

We see a pressing need to upgrade to a T-1 connection to provide more bandwidth (1.5M up/down). This will enable us to support a peak of 60 listeners and 500,000 Webhits/month.

Please join us in prayer that God will provide financially for us to upgrade to a T-1 soon.

Featured Questions and Answers

QUESTION: Bro. Branham taught that hell is As you can see from the Greek Lexicon, not eternal. I am familiar with Bro. Branham's teaching on this saying that no created things are eternal, only God is eternal and we have His Zoë life. Is heaven and hell eternal? Heaven was also created. Compare with Mark 3:29, Hebrews 6:2, Jude 1:7 and Revelations 20:10. What is the difference between eternal and everlasting (John 3:16, 2 Corinthians 5:1)?

ANSWER:

Mark 3:29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

aionios - eternal, everlasting, the world began, since the world began, for ever, without beginning and end, that which always has been and always will be, without beginning, without end, never to cease, **ever**lasting [Greek Lexicon]

eternal has several meanings.

Hebrews 6:2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

It does not say they will burn eternally but they have eternal separation. From eternity, they were separated from God.

Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal

Luke 17:29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all

.So how long did they burn? The attribute of eternal fire from God destroyed them they are not burning now.

Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and

aion ever, evermore, eternal, unto the ages of the ages, end of the age, period of time, age, a human lifetime [Greek Lexicon]

As you can see this also has several meanings

Jonah 2:6 I went down to the bottoms of the mountains; the earth with her bars was about me for ever: yet hast thou brought up my life from corruption, O LORD my God.

But Jonah Was Only In The Whale's Belly For Three Days!

In I Samuel 3:13-14, God told Samuel that He was going to judge the house of Eli forever, and that they would offer no more sacrifices "forever" as His priests. And in II Kings 2:27, Solomon thrust out the last descendants of Eli from the priesthood. That was four generations or so later. Now you can see that "everlasting" does not compare with what is "eternal"

Question: What is the difference between eternal and everlasting?

Exodus 40:15 And thou shalt anoint them, as thou didst anoint their father that they may minister unto me in the priest's office: for their anointing shall surely be an everlasting priesthood throughout their generations.

Numbers 25:13 And he shall have it, and his seed after him, even the covenant of an everlasting priesthood; because he was zealous for his God, and made an atonement for the children of Israel.

Jeremiah 20:11 But the LORD is with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten.

Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

Look at the word, "destruction" over in II Thessalonians 1:9, "Who shall be punished with destruction." **ever**lasting In the Greek, "destruction" positively means annihilation. And "destruction", does NOT mean the word,

destroying. Now "destroying" means something going on and on in decay. So what can everlasting annihilation mean? It doesn't mean to keep on annihilating, or that would make the word "destroying", instead of "destruction". It means to destroy to the ending point. End it [Smyrnaean Church Age – Church Age Book Cpt.4 134-11

You might wonder now, when you can use that word, "eternal", and not use it the way we have been taught. That is easy. When it applies to God it means to be without beginning or end, and ever enduring and never ceasing. And when you talk of eternal life you have that in mind which is the life of God. "This is the record, that God has given us eternal life, and that life is in the Son. He that hath the Son hath life." [Smyrnaean Church Age – Church Age Book Cpt.4 134-2]

Now then, only sons of God have life eternal, the kind that never had a beginning, but always was. That is right. You have something in you right now that is eternal--without beginning or end. It is the Spirit of God. It is a part of God Himself. It is the life of God. to hell and then suffer the same as you are going to heaven and enjoy heaven, then he has the same kind of life you have already. [Smyrnaean Church Age -Church Age Book Cpt.4 134-3]

Well, then there might be those who say eternal life signifies the welfare of the children of God. It is their welfare and enjoyment that is at stake. On the other hand the sinner goes to his punishment, so that we can reduce the second death to a matter of punishment and place. Eternal life means heaven, and eternal punishment means hell. You would be surprised at the men who have been exalted as theologians that believed that. But do you know what that does? It makes **eternal** life a matter of geography instead of a Person. Eternal life is God,--the Lord Jesus Christ. How anyone could believe such a thing, that **eternal** life is a matter of place, is more than I know. It makes me stagger to think of it. [Smyrnaean Church Age - Church Age Book Cpt.4 134-4]

So you see, that word **eternal**, or **ever**lasting, can be applied in various ways, but when it applies to God, He being what He is, it has one meaning. It is the duration of God. You can't apply it like that to any other thing. God alone is eternal, and because He lives, we live with Him. [Smyrnaean Church Age – Church Age Book Cpt.4 135-2]
