"But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak." [I Corinthians 8:9]

"I told a lady the other day, she was dressed so tight in her dress. I said, "Sister, that dress is too tight. It may not sound good for me to tell you that, but it is. You're a Christian, and you would make a stumblingblock." 119 She said, "Well, Brother Branham, you know what?" She said, "This is the only kind they make." 120 I said, "They still sell goods, and they got sewing machines. There is no excuse." Yeah. 121 Listen, let me tell you something, my dear friend. Not picking on you. No, Sir. I'm trying to keep you out of the torment. Long as that spirit is in you, you're going to do it. That's right. You have to be born out of it. QUESTION:

What is meant exactly "HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS" or complete explanation about Matthew 6:33?

ANSWER:

"But seek ye first the kingdom of God , and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." [Matthew 6:33]

"What is it? "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness," not the Kingdom of God or a little noise, not the Kingdom of God and a little emotion, not the Kingdom of God and a little this or that, but God in His righteousness and all these other things will be added to you. But first... Now, that widow heard that. "Faith cometh by hearing, hearing by the Word." She said, "That's the Word of the Lord for that's a holy man of God. That's God's prophet, and I know it's the truth and that's the Word of God." Now, she didn't run across to ask the neighbors how to do it. She didn't want to go to share her--to tell the neighbor said, "Well, what do you think? The preacher's over to my house saying this. Susie, what do you think about this?" She went ahead and begin to dump out. She let go. She let go of what she had that she might get more. That's what the world needs today is a good old fashion letting go of what you got. Hallelujah." 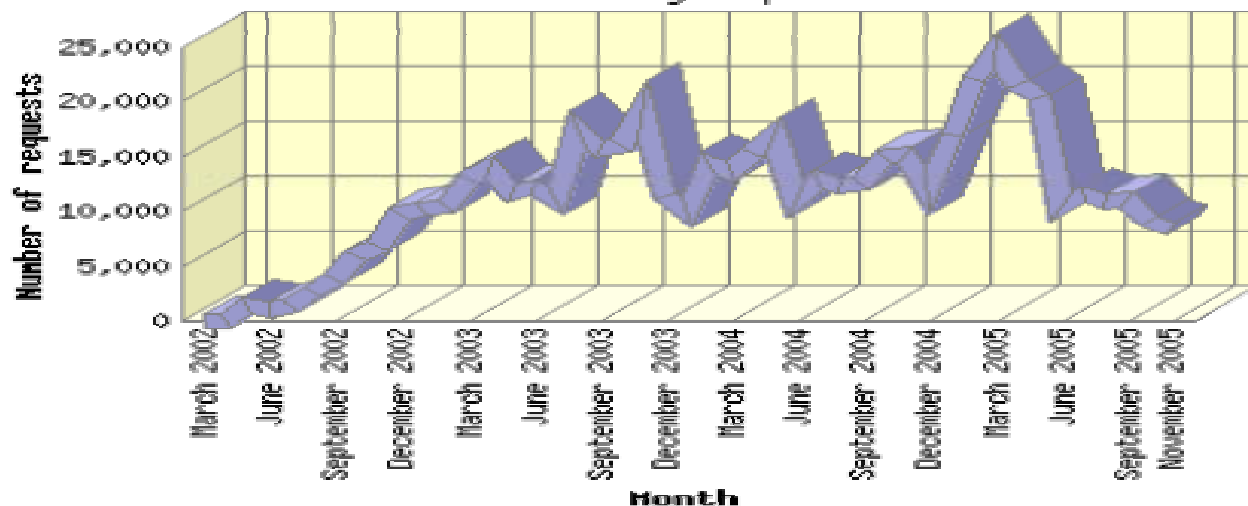

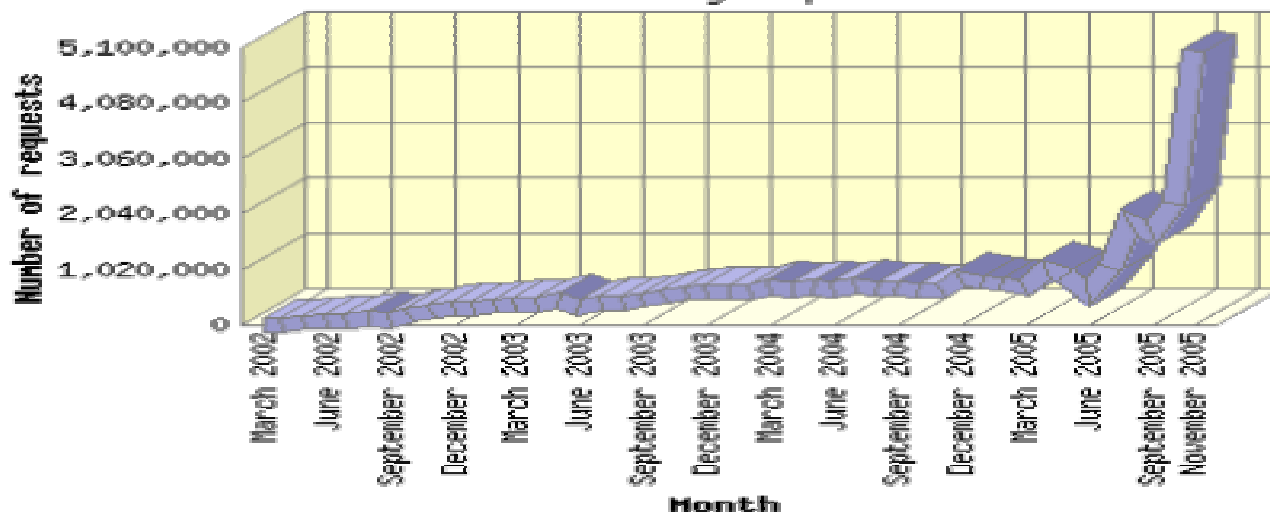
